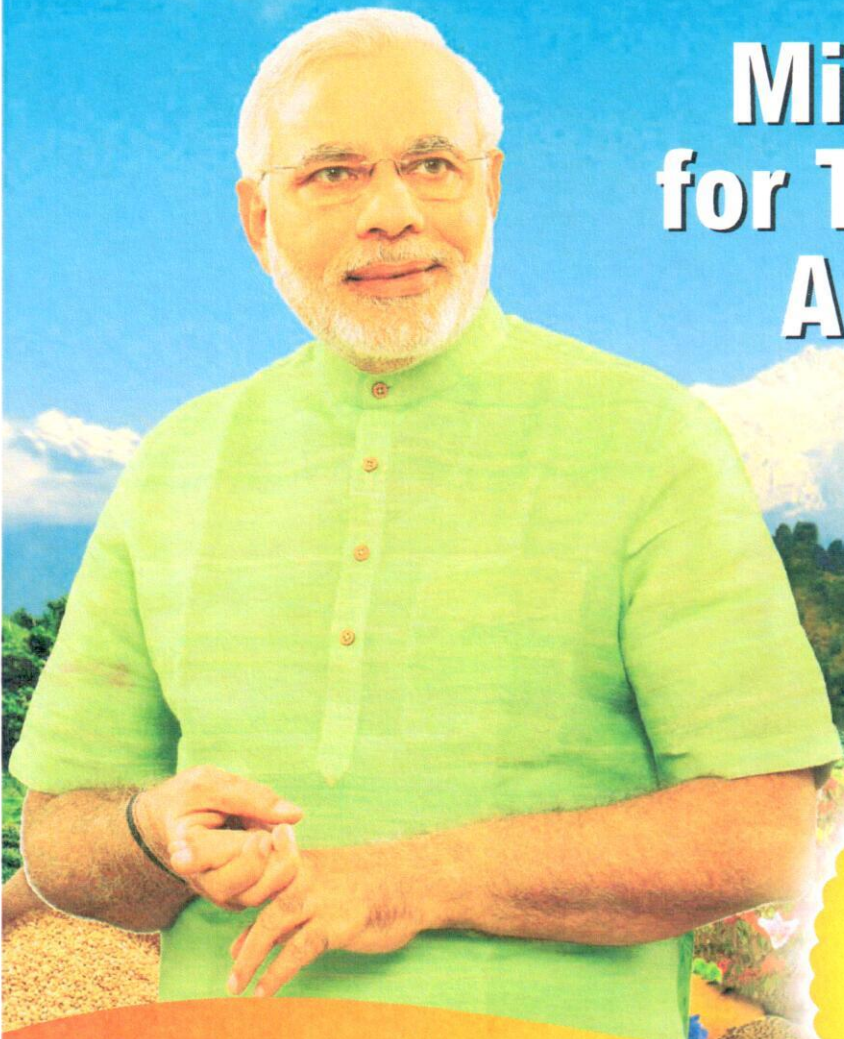

Climate Change: Efforts to devise approaches to tackle impact of climate changes in Indian agriculture, assessing and preventing its impact and finding ways for adaptation and mitigation.
