I ask you to provide.	<p>A Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Support to State Extension Programs for Extension Reforms" popularly known as ATMA Scheme is being implemented in 704 districts of 28 States & 5 UTs in the country (including all the 31 districts of Tamil Nadu). The Scheme promotes decentralized farmer-friendly extension system in the country. The objectives of the Scheme is to support State Government's efforts and to make available latest agricultural technologies and good agriculture practices in different thematic areas of agriculture and allied areas to farmers through different extension activities viz. Farmers Training, Demonstrations, Exposure Visits, Kisan Mela, Mobilization of Farmers Groups and organizing Farm Schools etc.</p> <p>Since the implementation of the scheme is in the domain of State Government, applicant is advised to seek farmer's data from the Commissioner of Agriculture-cum-State Nodal Officer (ATMA), Government of Tamil Nadu, Chepauk, Chennai-600005 (Tamil Nadu) or Deputy Project Director (ATMA) of the concerned district.</p>
