However, actual implementation of both ATMA activities as well as deployment of manpower is in the domain of State Government concerned. 

Under the ATMA Yojana, Guide line regarding Kisan Award given to farmers in the financial year 2019-20 and 2020-21 should be made available at block level, district level and state level.	In so far as ATMA Scheme is concerned, Cafeteria Activity A.7 of Annexure-III(a) ATMA Guidelines, 2018 provides for Farmers Award at State & District level and B.7 activity at Block level. However, actual implementation of ATMA activities including Farmers Award are in the domain of State Government concerned. ATMA Scheme Guidelines, 2018 are available in public domain (vide http://extensionreforms.dacnet.nic.in/PDF/atmaguid23814.pdf).
