Presently, the scheme is being implemented in 704 districts of 28 states & 5 UTs of the country [including all the 32 districts of Telangana State]. The scheme promotes decentralized farmer-driven and farmer-accountable extension system. Under the scheme grants-in-aid is released to the State Governments with an objective to support State Government's efforts to making available the latest agricultural technologies and good agricultural practices in different thematic areas of agriculture and allied sectors to farmers through difference extension activities viz. Farmers Training, Demonstrations, Exposure Visits, Kisan Mela, Mobilization of Farmers Groups and organizing Farm Schools etc. Since 2014-15, to till dated i.e. 19.01.2023, an amount of Rs. 6013.02 lakh (Central Share) has been released to the State Government of Telangana State to carry out extension activities and 6,00,927 farmers have been benefitted through different extension activities under the scheme. There is no provision of subsidy component under the ATMA Scheme. |
